



Reframing Heritage Education in Egypt (ReHeED)

RE : “Specialized Diploma and Master Programs in Cultural Heritage Education”- Validation

In the specific frame of the ReHeED project, co-founded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, the University of Paris 1 Panthéon Sorbonne had carefully examined the academic structure and contents of the new “Specialized Diploma” and “Master” Programs in “Cultural Heritage Education” proposed for the formation of Heritage professionals in the Egyptian Universities.
