





## Report on the Training Workshop on Maritime Cultural Heritage Education Alexandria University - 22-24 February 2022

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ project (Reframing Heritage Education in Egypt – ReHeEd), a training workshop on "Maritime Cultural Heritage Education" was held at Alexandria University from the 22<sup>nd</sup> to the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 2022.
